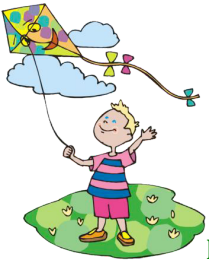

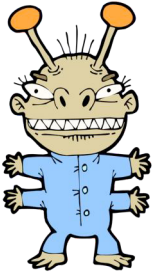

(Mot interrogatif +) Auxiliaire HAVE (conjugué au présent) + Sujet + PARTICIPE PASSÉ du verbe

Exemples : Has he done his homework ? Why has she closed the door ?
