A journey through hell

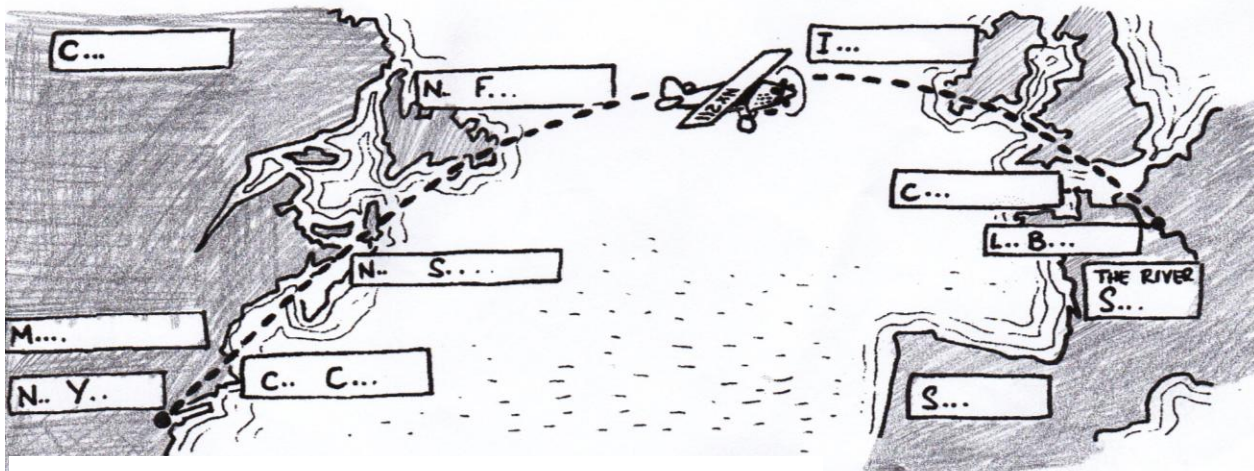
On May 20, at 7:52 a.m., the *Spirit of Saint Louis* took off from Roosevelt Airfield in New York. Lindbergh headed north and remained close to the coast, flying over Cape Cod, Massachusetts, and Nova Scotia, Canada. He reached Newfoundland as the sun was setting eleven hours later.

From hell to heaven

In the afternoon Lindbergh saw a few fishing boats.

"I had no idea where, between Ireland and Spain, they had come from", he said.

When the sun set for the second time, he was over Cherbourg. He then followed the river Seine as far as Paris, which he recognized thanks to the Eiffel Tower. A few minutes later he was at Le Bourget... and a hero!
